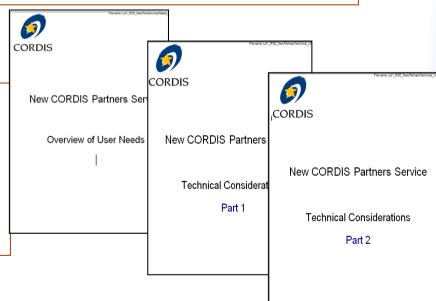

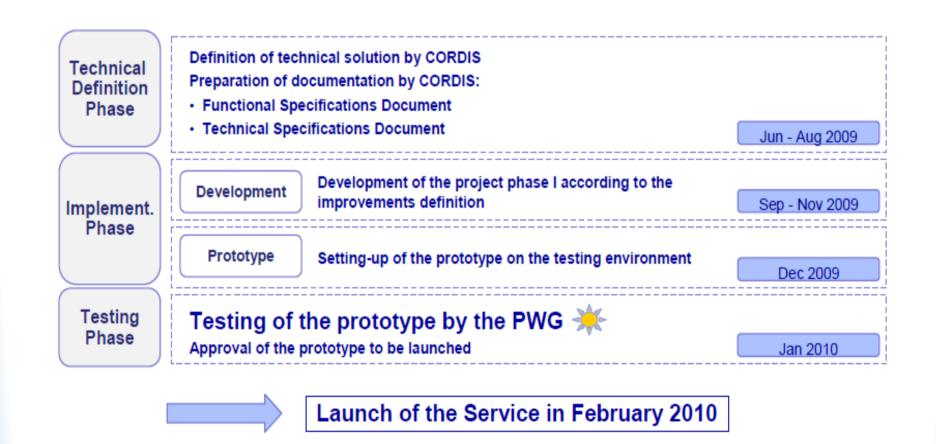


### **General Overview**

## CORDIS Partners Service will create a "closed community" for "particpants" and "intermediaries".

### Caractheristic:

- CLOSED: to all members registred providing a minimum set of information (everyone knows who is working with)
- OPEN: to any individual or organisation (provide minimum information)
- NETWORK SUPPORT FACILITIES: allowing partipants an intermediaries to exchange information, interact with each other, share documents, create working group, generate partnership, build proposals.
- PUBLIC SHOP-WINDOW: attract new members to the comunity (provide access to information just to registred member).

### **POTENTIAL USERS**

- Individual researchers, organisations or networks seeking to participate in research funding
- NCPs ('intermediaries')
- Users seeking to offer consultancy






### Management Information (2)

#### **CALL-ORIENTED PARTNERS SERVICE**

- "Partners search request" related to one specific Call
  - Partners search request to be deactivated automatically when the Call is closed
- Clear partner identification on the partners search request
  - providing useful information related to the specific Call,
  - role they intend to play on the project (project proposer, expertise offered, etc.)
- Calls related alerts
- Easy search by "Partners interested in this Call"

### Creating a partnership proposal



### Quality (1)

Ensure the highest possible quality of information about individuals, organisations and partnership offers/requests.

- Key information (mandatory fields)
- Partnership offer/request associated with a specific call
- Additional information (optional): e.g. CV, multi-media assets, link to "social networking" functions
- Link between profile(s) and relevant information stored in other CORDIS location (e.g. project database, results database, documents library, ect) or external to CORDIS (e.g. URF)
- Quality technical verification of new profile before the publication (errors, unclear information)
- Profile "hibernation" / "deletion"
- Partnership offer/request "hibernation" / "deletion"
- Statistic concering activities related to partnership offer/request

## Quality (2) Verification and 'approval' of data by recognised 'agents'

## The system should provide an option for NCPs to check data and to add their 'seal of approval'

- possibility to verify and 'validate' data from their 'client' organisations ('rating system' giving a notion of the level of reliability of the information)
- 'expert' group/quality team of NCPs from every thematic area to qualitycheck profiles....but
  - Time constraints
  - NCPs/experts commitment?
- Publication by country NCP + QA Team
- Quality Label: in relationship to the "fit" between the partnership profile and the call/topic (internal forum for communication between NCPs concerning quality-checking and/or discussions concerning the profiles)

## Simple word-search will be accessible from the home page of the Partner Service

### "SIMPLE SEARCH BOX":

- one or more search terms
- option to restrict the search (pre-fillering)
- set of multiple (multiple selection in each category) pre-selection tick-box menus (organisation type, country/regions, theme, call)
- search results printable, sortable, savable, exportable or download (able)

### Option to select an "AUTOMATIC MATCH-MAKER" function:

The system compares the user's requests with other individual or organisation profiles


## Easy navigation between items using search tecnologies, hyperlinks on criteria will launch new searches.

### Different views of the same information:

- the partner view: main information of the partner, which calls and projects the parnter has participated in
- the call view: wich potencial partner expressed interest

### **Networking facilities**

- SHARING AND WORKING SPACES
  - Project proposals, sharing documents, create documents together,...
  - Comment on the proposals of others
  - Express interest in a project
- FORUMS
  - Feedback on experiences...
- INTER-PERSONAL MESSAGING SYSTEM
- CHAT
- WIKI
  - E.g. guides on how to prepare good proposals, to communicate on EUfunding opportunities, etc.
- These facilities could be enabled or disabled as desired

### Reuse of information

### To allow users to link their profiles to other web resources

(e.g. RSS inward feeds to assure a company profile is automatically updated).

To **extract datasets** for use outside the facility:

- Bulk download of multiple datasets
- Printing of search result list
- Export of selected profiles into a "standard brochure" (CORDIS will offer a standard layout with introductory texts, explanations that could be used directly)
- Announce succesful partnership (e.g. research funding obtained) and/or success stories (e.g. long term economic benefits)
- Open standards to facilitate the exchange of data with other system
- Reporting....





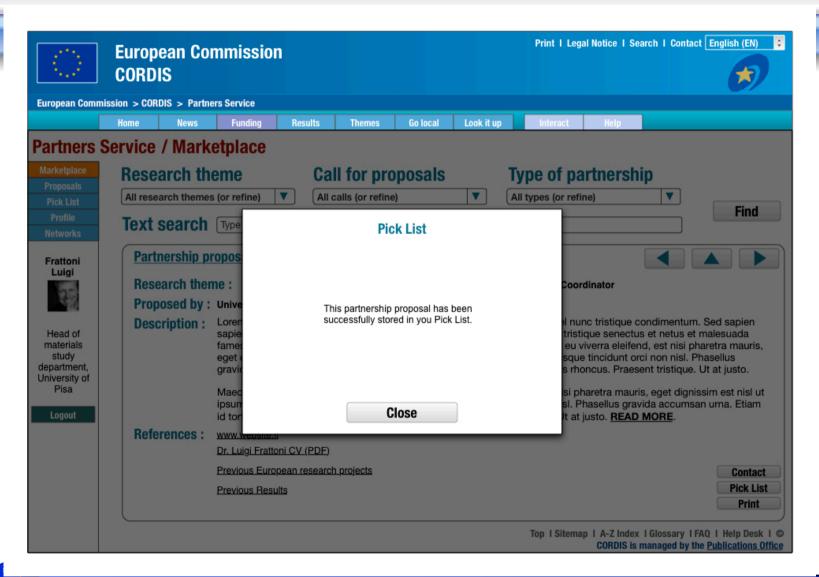

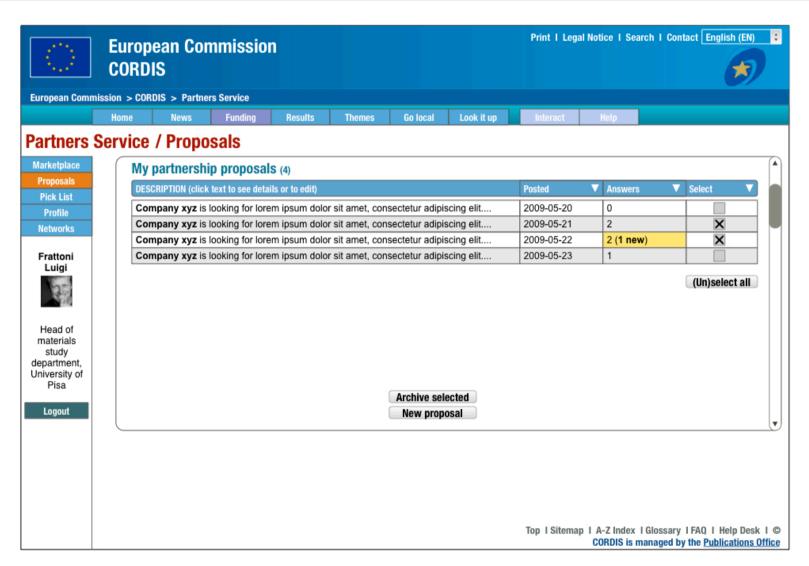
